The Clean Vehicles Directive (2009/33/EG) entred in force 2009.

- Amendment Directive (EU) 2019/1161) entred in force augusti 2019.
- Implemented in each Member States legislation by augusti 2021.
- Regulates the proportion of Clean Vehicles to be procured in certain procurements. The concept of clean vehicles includes emission efficient vehicles and emission-free vehicles.



What are clean vehicles ?

Light vehicles

- Emission-efficient vehicles: maximum 50 g CO2 / km from the exhaust pipe and a maximum of 80% emissions of the levels in the vehicle's Euroclass.
- Emission-free vehicles: 0 g CO2 / km from the exhaust pipe.

Heavy vehicles

- Electricity
- Plugg-in Hybrid
- Hydrogen
- Biofuel
- Vehicle gas (gaseous and liquid)
- LPG
- Synthetic and paraffinic fuels

Emission-free heavy vehicles:

 A clean vehicle without an internal combustion engine or with an internal combustion engine that emits less than 1 g CO2 / kWh.



Scope of the Directive

Applies to all contracting authorities and entities subject to the Public Procurement Act.
