Paxster AS offers a 100% electric vehicle for sustainable and efficient distribution of goods in urban areas.

We have developed an electric vehicle, tailor made for smart city logistics solutions whether that is last mile delivery of post and parcels, food and retail or any other kind of goods or service of a suitable kind. The Paxster has a small footprint and is ¼ the weight of a regular van and with its unique, semi-open design, having the driver's ergonomics and the environment in focus, both the users and the public meeting them on the roads appreciate this work tool.

With a loading capacity of more than 1m³ and a 9,2kWh battery, the Paxster will take you up to 100km on a full charge at maximum speed of 45 or 60km/h.

Small footprint - Big impact

With the explosive growth in e-commerce, changing consumer behaviours and expectations in combination with growing cities, less space available for vehicles to move and the urgent need for more sustainable solutions, a change is urgently required. Logistics companies under constant cost pressure, are forced to find greener, more cost-efficient solutions.

40% of parcels delivered today are smaller than a shoe box in size and 30% of deliveries are single units. Consumers of tomorrow will no longer accept having their new cell phone delivered by a courier driving a large diesel-van to their doorstep.
