In 2018 the Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) assisted 1 196 142 people with information, counselling and legal assistance. Today, NRC assists displaced people through face-to-face contact. The delivery of assistance is limited by time, resources available, access constraints and geography. Digital innovation has the potential to create solutions that can overcome these obstacles.
